A RESOLUTION FOR THE MESA COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DIVISION DECREASING THE LANDFILL'S MINIMUM DISPOSAL FEE

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of C.R.S. 30-20-100.5, *et seq.*, Mesa County has a Solid Waste Management Division (the Division) charged with the responsibility of developing and managing solid waste management programs and facilities, including a municipal solid waste landfill, a hazardous waste collection facility, an organic materials composting facility, and four (4) waste transfer stations; and

WHEREAS, the Division is a business subset (Enterprise Fund) of Mesa County government, meaning it receives no more than 10% of its expenses from the General Fund to own and operate the various programs and activities provided by the Division; and

WHEREAS, the activities of the Division are primarily funded by revenue from tipping fees and, to a lesser degree, fees associated with the Organic Materials Composting Facility and the Hazardous Waste Collection Facility; and

WHEREAS, Mesa County is committed to providing all residents with fiscally accessible waste disposal options.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MESA, COLORADO, THAT THE MINIMUM DISPOSAL FEE CURRENTLY IN EFFECT AT THE MESA COUNTY LANDFILL IS SUPERSEDED AND SHALL NOW BE SET AT \$10.00 FOR UP TO 380 POUNDS. ALL OTHER FEES SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT.

This resolution supersedes all previous resolutions establishing fees for the Division.
